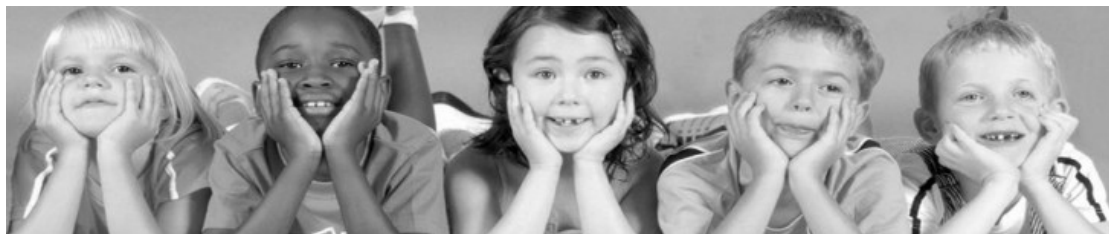


ABA for Speech and Language Therapists
